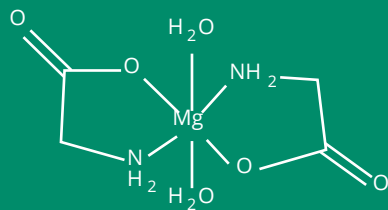

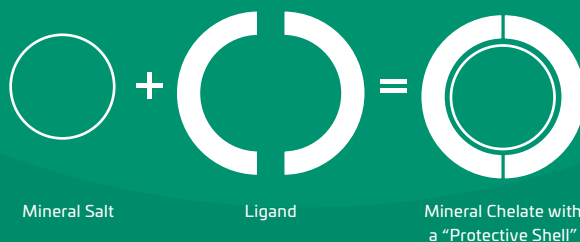
What is a Chelate?

Magnesium Bisglycinate

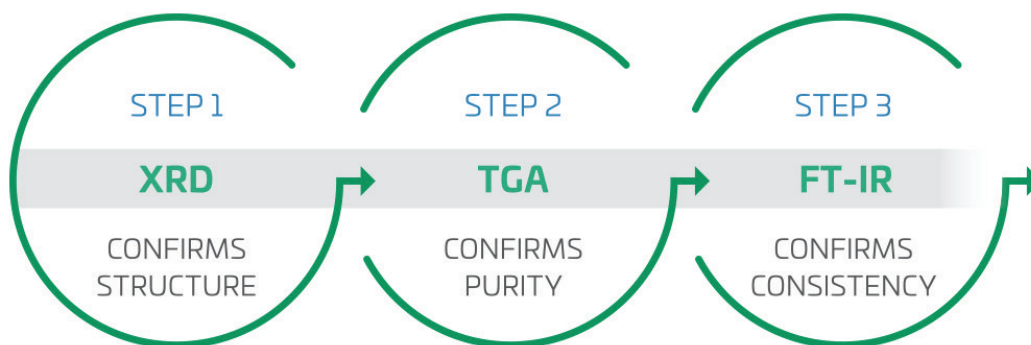
When ligands chelate a mineral, they form a protective shell around it.
